

The City of Lights, which attracts 30,000 people will be on Wednesday 21st November.



#### Shopwatch - meeting reminder and radios

Everyone is welcome to come along to the Shop Watch meetings on the first Tuesday of each month which shares information and aims to help Truro businesses feel safe and prevent crime. The next meeting is August 7th, 10am in the Truro BID meeting room, first floor above the Library main entrance. As part of Truro Safe, Devon and Cornwall's Police and Crime Commissioner has awarded Truro BID £3,000 to improve communications and help reduce shop lifting. We've bought Shopwatch radios which we will distribute at suitable locations around our City Centre.
