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## HIGHWAY AND FOOTWAY IMPROVEMENT | *September - November 2026*

### Boscawen Street and Lemon Street Truro

Traffic management will be in place in Truro city centre from Monday 7 September until Friday 6 November to allow essential repairs to be carried out on Boscawen Street and footway improvements on Lower Lemon Street.

We have planned these works to take place at the same time, to reduce the overall duration of the programme and minimise disruption. To carry out repairs to the existing granite setts on Boscawen Street, a road closure and give and take traffic management arrangements will be required. A separate road closure will also be needed on Lower Lemon Street to enable repairs to the granite footways.

Please be advised that all traffic management measures will remain in place 24 hours a day, seven days a week, until completion of the projects.

We recognise that these works will affect local traffic and have carefully planned the programme to keep disruption to a minimum while carrying out these essential repairs.

Your understanding and cooperation during this period are greatly appreciated.

## Why is the work needed?

We are carrying out further repairs to sections of granite setts on Boscawen Street and granite paving on Lower Lemon Street.

As part of an ongoing programme of improvements, these works focus on areas that have not previously been repaired. Due to city centre events, busy trading periods and the specialist nature of the work, there is only a limited window each year when these repairs can be carried out. Delivering the works in phases helps minimise disruption while ensuring Truro's historic streets remain safe and well maintained.

## What work is taking place?

On Boscawen Street, we will be lifting, cleaning and relaying sections of granite setts in six locations where repairs are needed.

On Lower Lemon Street, we will be repairing areas of granite paving outside Mannings Hotel, Michael Spiers and on the opposite side of the road. The paving will be removed, the underlying foundation rebuilt where needed, and the granites reset to create a safer and more durable surface.

Our work will be completed before the Remembrance Sunday parade and events leading up to Christmas.

For safety reasons and to allow materials to cure effectively, the road closures and associated traffic management will need to remain in place until the work is completed.

## Access arrangements

Suitable barrier systems will be in place to safely separate pedestrians from hazards to provide a safe route around our works.

Bus companies and the emergency services have been informed about the road closure and will make alternative arrangements as needed.

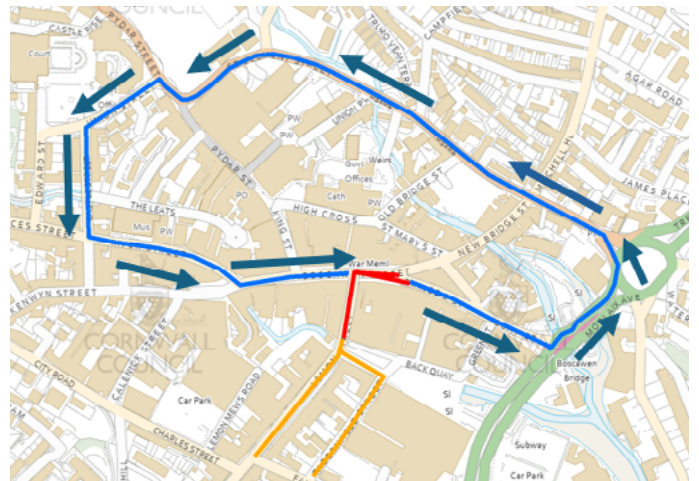

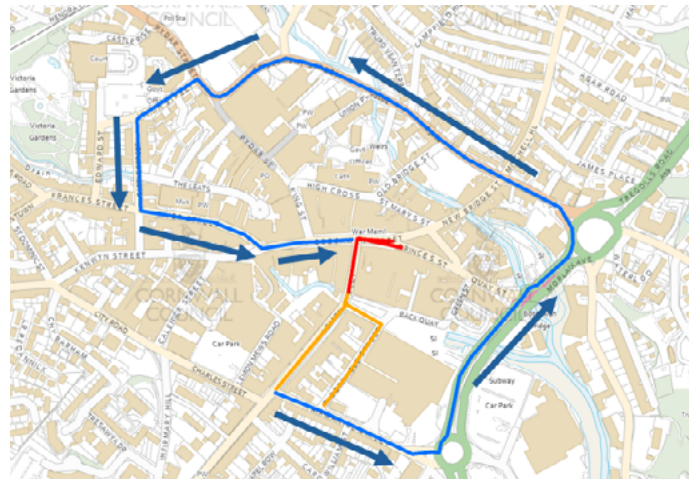
## Diversion
